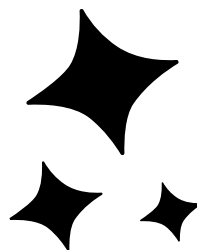

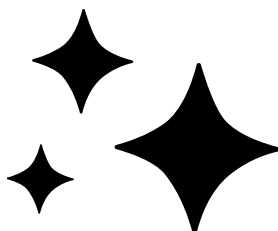
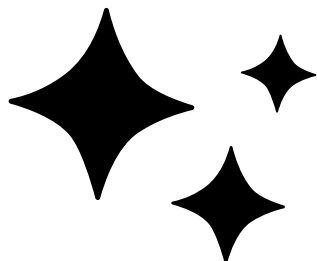

"We admitted that we were powerless over our addiction, that our lives had become unmanageable."

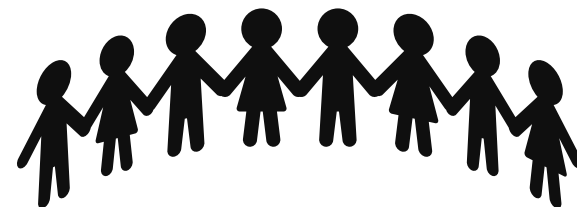

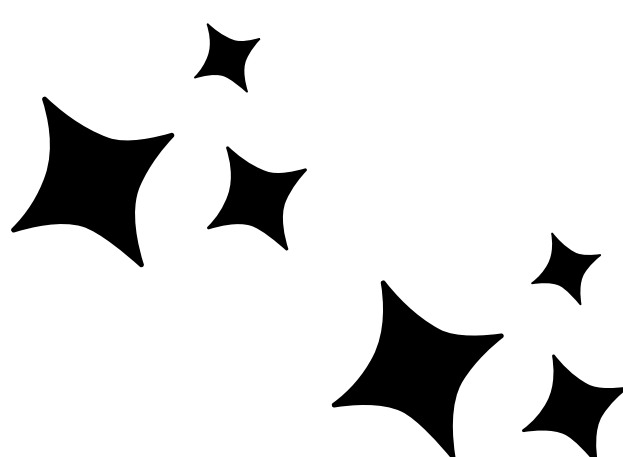
